



Possible Side Effects of Influenza Vaccine:

Influenza vaccines are usually very well tolerated. However, some people might develop some side effects from the vaccine.

Common side effects:

- Local reaction around injection site (redness, pain, and swelling). Try ice pad to relief symptoms.
- Headache, fever, weakness, aching muscles and joints, lasting for 1-2 days. Please take panadol for symptoms relief.

Rare but important side effects to look out for:

(These are rare but serious side effects, and urgent medical attention should be sought)

- Signs of allergy (rash, swollen lips, difficulty in breathing)
- Headache and high temperatures for more than 2 days
- Tingling of the hands or feet or sudden numbness or weakness in legs
